Meeting called to order by President Andy Herlihy at 2001 hours.

1. Financial Report (Judy Quinn)

A. Treasurer's Report

- o Association P & L Statement (2020-12-31) and Balance Sheet (2020-12-31) below.
- Very few expenses in 2020; mostly fixed costs. This tells us that our dues structure is sound.
- o Lost ~ \$825; Outstanding 2020 Dues (5 clubs) = \$1000

B. Dues Proposal from 2021

- O Dues invoices to be mailed out around March 10th.
- Clubs that did not pay their 2020 dues, must pay full 2020 dues to remain in good standing.
- o 2021 Dues structure
 - \circ Big clubs = \$500 (paid by 5/1/21), \$600 if paid after that date
 - \circ Small clubs = \$250 (paid by 5/1/21), \$300 if paid after that date
 - \circ School = \$75 (paid by 5/1/21), \$100 if paid after that date
- This is not a dues reduction, but a recognition that some clubs may still be struggling financially. It also ensures that SMSA has some working capital to support our fixed costs in 2021
- o Proposal passed with fully supported by the board

2. Junior Programs Discussion.

A. Update from clubs

- o Stone Horse YC Season like 2020. Hoping to attend regatta
- CBC Plan to mimic program from last summer (60% capacity). Sea Squirt program built in a literacy portion
- o Bass River YC Back to normal, ramping up.
- o Edgartown YC Back to normal. Held programs last summer and it was successful.
- o **Falmouth Harbor SS** Back to normal. Will have Opti and C420 racing. 8-week schedule. Adding adventure sailing for the first time.
- Yarmouth Sailing Same protocols as last summer. Hoping to add capacity if protocol will allow. May not be able to hoist regattas in 2021.

- Chatham YC Similar to 2020 with spacing, etc. 100 anniversary year of the club.
 Hoping for social events. Planning to host Chatham regatta and 100 anniversary of the L Telesmanick.
- \circ **Quissett YC** 60-80% capacity. Trying to figure out what age to start lessons. Probably will not starting as young this year nor mixing kids in Bullseyes
- o **Hyannis YC** Full program, full regatta schedule at HYC and travel team.
- o Barnstable YC Similar to 2020. Will follow protocols and run classes.
- **Vineyard Haven YC** 2020 was best summer ever. Stayed at home and focused on seamanship. Scaled back number of regattas that we will travel to. Will we run your tadpoles (youngest kids) class in 2021?
- o Wianno YC will run a program in 2020. Scope to be determined.
- Onset Bay Center Will start first year of sailing instruction. 2020 was supposed to be our first year, but we did not sail last summer. Teen learn to sail; family learning to sail program (people of one household in Quests.
- o Beverly YC planning a near normal season no modification

Question: What age do you start teaching little kids?

- O Three in a beetle cat getting guys to be on the water
- o Institute a lot of fleets that helps maintain interest

Questions: Staff Issues?

- o Clubs that build from within are finding instructors leaving for internships.
- o Several clubs still looking for race coaches.
- o OBC working with MMA to provide sailing instructors

Questions: Housing.

o Stone Horse, Edgartown and Vineyard Have have club owned housing.

Question: Instructor training – who pays?

- o Reimbursement for certification. Most clubs do this.
- o Recommendation: Reimburse half of cost once certification is earned. Reimburse the other half if they commit to coming back the following year.

Questions: Lifeguard Certification?

- Where are people getting this certification now that CCSC has closed (they use to be the certification site).
- YMCA in Wareham filling that void off Cape. Check with YMCA of Cape Cod (West Barnstable)

Question: Compensation from Coach & Instructors?

- Edgartown YC: All instructor and coaches make \$17.50/hour. This is a chance from 2019/2020. Some instructors can make more \$\$ teaching private lessons through the club (cut of the hourly fee).
- o Barnstable YC: pay scale depending on years of serves (\$1/year raise). Can earn more private lessons booking through the club.
- o CBC: Pay tied to level of certifications. Starting basis min wage.
- o Beverly: Private lessons are through clubs.
- O Vineyard: Pays salary for certain positions. (i.e. Race coach, head instructor). Private lessons though club.
- o Stone Horse: Salary for coaches/ Instructors get paid hourly wage
- Quissett; Private lessons through club. Last year we moved to hourly wage, but moving back to salary for Head Coach but minimum wage for instructors
- o Falmouth SS: Private lessons through club.

3. Other Business:

A. Training:

- o More in-person level-1 classes have been added to the calendar
- o Level-2 classes will be coming online in the next 2 weeks.

B. SM Sailing Regattas

- o Junior events (Gill, Durant, & Cumming) have been scheduled.
- o Area A events (Bemis & Smythe) are scheduled. Sears qualifier still unknown.
- o Adult events will be finalized by next meeting
